For the quarter ending March 31, 2021, the GW Investment Institute Student Investment Funds (GWII SIFs) returned 2.3% vs. 6.2% for the S&P 500 Index and for the trailing one year the GWII SIF returned 56.5% vs. 56.3% for the S&P 500 Index.
