

2016 FITE Fellowships



The Institut Francais and the Indonesian Ministry of Tourism invite GWU students to apply for a 2016 FITE Fellowship at the Forum on International Tourism and the Environment (“FITE”). FITE Fellows will apply their communications and research skills to the task of creating an online resource designed to support the 2016 FITE Student Congress in Bali, Indonesia. This will include conducting online video interviews with sustainable tourism experts, researching sustainable tourism, and writing and recording demonstration videos on sustainable tourism.

All FITE Fellows will receive letters of commendation from the Indonesian Ministry of Tourism and the Institut Francais. One FITE Fellow will receive full funding (including airfare to Bali) to attend the FITE Student Congress in Bali on June 4 & 5, 2016. All FITE Fellows will be invited to the Student Congress and will receive funding for meals, hotels and local transportation (excluding airfare to Bali) should they decide to attend.
